Parents/Guardians of Incoming Freshmen Students,

One of the “business” items we typically take care of with course selection in January is the collection of some initial paperwork for incoming Freshmen students. Since we are not doing course selection in person, we are asking that you mail via USPS or email the paperwork listed below to tpregistration@bhsd228.com.

- Original Birth Certificate
- Identification
 - Parent/Guardian must provide **one** of the following proofs of identification:
 - Current Illinois Driver's License
 - Current Illinois State ID
- Residency Verification
 - Parent/Guardian must provide the following:
 - **Two** current utility bills (last 2 months) ie., water, gas, electricity, cable, phone
 - Parent/Guardian must provide **one** of the following along with the utility bills
 - Proof of mortgage
 - Proof of property tax
 - Rental lease
- Custody Papers (Necessary only if parent/guardian name is not on birth certificate)

Additional enrollment requirements will need to be met if living with another family.

This is the initial step in the registration process for new students. We must have ALL of the above paperwork by **April 2, 2021** in order for you to receive the official online registration information for your student when we send that out later this Spring.
